Membership

All persons playing tennis (both seniors and juniors) must be a financial member. All members must complete the online application form (www.ouyentennis.com.au) or paper form available (see treasurer) and pay fees by the 3rd round of the current tennis season.

After being a fill in for 3 games of any competition a player needs to become a full financial member.

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Friday Night Seniors and Teens Competitions

Players should be at the clubhouse by 6.15 pm, to make sure people are on the courts by 6.30 pm (not just arriving). Friday night dinners will be posted on the clubs Facebook page, the meal will be ready at 6 pm so players can eat before tennis starts.

Captains are to ensure you have a full team prior to 6 pm Friday nights and complete team sheets. If you are unavailable to play, please contact your team captain early in the week to help organise a fill-in who is a similar skill level.

Junior Competition

Junior tennis is played on Friday afternoons at 4.00 pm with an optional half hour training session. Competition starts at 4.30 pm and finished about 6.00 pm. Junior players need to be able to serve the ball and know how to score. All players need to be members through either a family or junior membership. Juniors will play three sets of tennis. Players will be given a team list and a list of fill ins at the start of the season and are asked to find their own fill in if they are unable to play. Children are assisted courtside by parents. A parent roster will be in place so could parents please ensure they take their turn or swap with someone if unavailable.

Heat rule: Junior tennis will be cancelled when the forecast is 37°c or higher, there will be cancellation posts on the Junior Tennis Facebook page on the Thursday. Senior tennis may be cancelled or have a delayed start time when the forecast is 39°c or higher. The committee will notify team captains and post updates on the clubs Facebook page. Wet weather rule: The committee is responsible for cancellation of matches if courts are unsafe due to rain or inclement conditions.
